I can confirm that ECIPS and CYBERPOL, after moving their registered seat to the UK, are no longer active in Belgium. However, this does not mean that the organizations have legally ceased to exist.

The transfer of the registered seats has led to modifications of the registration in the Belgian register (*KBO – Kruispuntbank van Ondernemingen / BCE – Banque-Carrefour des Entreprises*). The legal situation has been modified, now indicating that both organizations have stopped their activities in Belgium.

Our Public Search website also mentions a status for each registered entity. This status is a technical characteristic linked to the legal situation of the entity. It has no legal value. The legal situation which is registered for both organizations will automatically give “stopped” as status. This indicates that the attributed enterprise number, and not the organization itself, is considered to be inactive.

The concept “enterprise” used by the KBO/BCE, should not be interpreted as a “company”, but as “an entity that had to be registered”.
